

General Election

November 3, 2020

(Bullet Points Based on Governor Murphy's Executive Order 177)

- All "Active" registered voters will receive a Vote-By-Mail ballot without needing to apply for it. The VBM ballots will be mailed to voters on or before the 29th day before the General Election.
- All Vote-By-Mail ballots will come with prepaid First-Class postage in order to return the ballot. Follow the instructions included to complete and return your ballot.
- NO sample ballots will be mailed out this year.
- All "Active" voters will receive a notice advising their polling location.
- Secure ballot drop boxes will be placed throughout the county; a drop box is scheduled to be placed at the Maurice River Township Municipal Building.
- One polling location will be open on Election Day for Maurice River Township voters: John Boggs Hall, 152 Port Elizabeth Cumberland Road. All voters for District 1 & District 2 may vote at this location.
- On Election Day the number of permitted voters will be based on social distancing of at least 6 feet for voters and poll workers. Signage is required with demarcation of six feet spacing.
- Infection control practices are required.
- Voters who receive Vote-By-Mail ballots and do not return them may vote at the polling location on Election Day but it will be by Provisional Ballot. Only disabled voters will be permitted to use the voting machines.
- Vote-By-Mail Ballots may be dropped at the polling location the day of the Election.
