ORDINANCE NO. 636

AN ORDINANCE OF MAURICE RIVER TOWNSHIP,  
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, GRANTING RENEWED CONSENT  
AND PERMISSION TO SOUTH JERSEY GAS COMPANY  
TO USE THE PUBLIC STREETS TO FURNISH  
GAS FOR LIGHT, HEAT AND POWER WITHIN  
MAURICE RIVER TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, South Jersey Gas Company, a corporation of the State of New Jersey, provides natural gas to Maurice River Township pursuant to the municipal consent first granted to South Jersey Gas Company by way of Ordinance No. 145 adopted on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of July, 1952; and

WHEREAS, South Jersey Gas Company, now seeks, pursuant to NJSA 48:3-15, the consent of Maurice River Township to renew § 1 of Ordinance 145 applicable to the use of streets within Maurice River Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has determined that consent and permission to use the public streets to furnish gas for light, heat and power within Maurice River Township previously granted to South Jersey Gas should be extended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED that the Township Committee of the Township of Maurice River, County of Cumberland, State of New Jersey, hereby extends Ordinance 145 as follows: § 1. That consent and permission is hereby renewed

and granted to South Jersey Gas Company to lay and construct its pipes and mains and related appurtenances and facilities below the streets, alleys, squares and public places within Maurice River Township in the manner prescribed by NJSA 48:9-21, and subject to reasonable regulations imposed by ordinance or resolution with respect to the opening of streets and public places, subject to approval of such consent and permission by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities.

§ 2. This consent is granted for the entire geographical area of Maurice River Township and extend to the boundaries of Maurice River Township and shall remain in effect for a period of fifty (50) years from the date of final adoption of this ordinance.


§ 3. If any section, sub-section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Township Committee of the Township of Maurice River, County of Cumberland
