ORDINANCE NO. 661

**AN ORDINANCE OF MAURICE RIVER TOWNSHIP,
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, AMENDING § 7-7.3
OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF MAURICE RIVER, TEMPORARY PARKING
PROHIBITION FOR SNOWPLOWING AND REMOVAL**

WHEREAS, § 7-7.3, Temporary Parking Prohibition for Snowplowing and Removal, of the revised General Ordinances of the Township of Maurice River was previously adopted by the Township Committee; and

WHEREAS, § 7-7.3 reserved the streets within Maurice River Township where temporary parking is to be prohibited for snowplowing and removal; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has determined that § 7-7.3 should be amended to reflect temporary no parking for snowplowing and removal in order to facilitate snow removal along the designated streets being in the interest of public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, that the Township Committee of the Township of Maurice River, County of Cumberland, State of New Jersey, does hereby amend § 7-7.3, Temporary Parking Prohibition for Snowplowing and Removal as follows:

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>SIDES</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>
Quaker Street (In Port Elizabeth)	Both	Entire Roadway Length
Front Street (In Dorchester)	Both	Entire Roadway Length

All other provisions of Chapter 7, Traffic, as set forth in the revised general Ordinances of the Township of Maurice River, shall remain in full force and effect except as amended by this Ordinance.

Severability: Severability: Should any section, sentence, clause or provision or a portion of this Ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect or impact upon any other section, sentence, clause or provision or portion of this Ordinance and the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Township Committee of the Township of Maurice River, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the adoption and publication of notice of adoption as prescribed by law.
