A synopsis of Resolution No. 135-2014 was given by Denise Peterson, Deputy Municipal Clerk.

Frank DiDomenico opened the bidding for the property of Block 221 Lots 33 and 34. He stated that the Tax Assessor had assessed the value of these properties at \$900.00 and both lots are undersized for the zone and unbuildable and that one of the lots is land locked. Statute 40A:12-13 permits the Township Committee to sell the lots to contiguous land owners.

Mrs. Ireland made a motion to adopt Resolution #135-2014, seconded by Mrs. Gross.

Frank DiDomenico indicated that the Township Clerk did send notification letters to the two contiguous property owners, Ronald and Eileen Farabella who are the owners of Lot 32 and Joseph and Brenda Sterling who are the owners of Lot 34. Mr. & Mrs. Farabella have notified that they are offering \$900.00. Joe Sterling verbally notified the municipal clerk's office that he would not be attending.

Frank DiDomenico verified the offer of \$900.00 and that prior to the meeting notification was made of the fees of \$100 for deed preparation and the recording fee of \$60. Total fee would be \$1,060.00 and 10% must be paid this evening.

Mr. Ronald Farabella was agreeable to the total cost of \$1,060.00 for property Block 221 Lot 33 and 34.

George Kumor of Heislerville, NJ thanked the Township Committee for its support in the bunker issue for the Delaware Bay and Maurice River fisherman. New legislation A2684/S1844 was passed this year which was within 7 months of starting the project. The amended legislation created new category that allows for anyone with a net, crab or fish pot license to obtain a bunker permit to obtain unlimited amounts of bunker for their own use and to sell 500 pounds a day. It also eliminated electronic mandatory filing for landing reports; paper landing reports are now acceptable. Also this was implemented into Federal Management plan.

Also there was success in obtaining \$10,000 grant for anyone who had a saltwater commercial license who suffered a loss due to Hurricane Sandi. Everyone was notified of the available funds. The deadline for filing was October 30, 2014.

Mr. Kumor stated that Maurice River Township was now on the map as being somebody that would pursue what we need in a manner that is beneficial to everyone.

Mr. Kumor expressed concern which may be a Economic Development issue. That the Maurice River Township School District sold coupon books for \$25; however the coupon book did not include any local businesses. Maybe a book could be established listing the local business that the students could sell.

Mr. Sarclette thanked Mr. Kumor for his efforts to make the Menhaden project a success. His knowledge was very valuable toward the effort.

Mrs. Gross asked if Mr. Kumor had a list of local licensed fisherman that may be interested in attending the Economic Development business meetings.

Mr. Kumor will work on getting this list.

Mrs. Shreve of 120 High Street requested that the tree limb be taken care of and thanked the Township Committee for the sign placed at her Oak Tree.

Mr. Sarclette indicated he will see what can be done.

Mr. Kumor stated that there is a lot of positive feedback regarding the Veterans Vending Park.

Ben Stowman stated that historical grant funding for East Point Light House in the amount of \$500,000 is approved. Additionally, the mouth of the Maurice River project has some renewed interest and they are trying to get to the planning process stage. Meetings are scheduled with Dorina Fazzaro.

Township Committee Reports

Kathy Ireland reported that Governor Christie announced that Maurice River East Point Lighthouse will be receiving \$500,000 historical grant for shoreline and grounds protection for the East Point Lighthouse. This is to be used as the Maurice River Township's share for the US Army Corp of Engineers project. Estimated value needed for that project was \$630,000. We are not quite sure of the final cost yet but we do have \$500,000. There are other non-profits trying to get in on the project. She will contact the Army Corp of Engineers to get an update on the project, the cost and any remaining balance.

Kathy Ireland reported that the Environmental Committee has met and they would like to take another trip down to Thompson's Beach to document the successes and failures of the project.

Kathy Ireland requested a letter to NJ Future's to extend the pro bono planner, Nick Graviano's 18 month period for another 18 months. He has been very helpful in obtaining grants and projects.

Patti Gross the Veteran's Vending sign has been installed. The sign was taken to the Maurice River Township Elementary School for their Veterans Day celebration. Laurie Pettigrew from NFWF was also there for the celebration. Plans are being made to have a "ribbon cutting" celebration in April 2015. She is going to contact the county to get help promoting the park.

On December 6th, 2014 there is a Holiday Bazaar at the Maurice River Township Elementary School with approximately 30 vendors attending. The Economic Development Committee is having a table to promote Buy Local and also several information tables.

Engineer

Estell Manor Road-NJDOT Grant	There is still some final side of the road work needed to be done by South State. Hoping to be closed out by the next meeting.
Schooner Landing Road Dead End	Engineer' certification is pending. I have reviewed the additional area to designate for no parking and a second trip is needed for additional measurements.
MRT School Drive Ponding	We have been working with the school on the ponding and gave them an estimate with options. We are waiting to hear from the school.
Leechester Hall Drainage	Preliminary design pending. Soil evaluation through boring or have the public works to dig a couple pits on the one side to see where ground water. He feels it will be shallow because the soils are marginal. This enable solving of the drainage issue.
Fuel Tank Canopy	T. Slack was the State Vendor for the fuel tanks and may qualify as the State Vendor for the canopy. T. Slack has done some work with a couple providers/suppliers and will be in contact with him with ideas and quotes. Cost is not available yet. Also checking into doing a solar canopy and what the energy would be used for.
Bay Avenue	It is possible where the road has been massaged and reconstructed that speed limit reduction may be possible. Mr. Sarclette stated that if he feels that if there is a chance to reduce but that it would still need to be patrolled and enforced.

MRT Signage

Mr. Morrissey indicated that he feels there is a possibility that current speed limit of 25 mph can be reduced to 15 mph.

Meeting next week with Nick Graviano
Positive discussion with NJDOT regarding RT 55 exit to Schooner Landing as well as the marina signs. They have been ordered. He will be notified when they are complete.

Veasey Driveway

Reviewed the driveway. He spoke to the NJDOT and they informed him that Route 47 was micro surfaced which is about 1/4 inch of pavement on the existing pavement. This did not create a significant difference in the driveway. NJDOT representative trying to get contractor back out to fix other problems found in the job and then driveway can be fixed with these materials.

Public Works Utility Poles

Met with electrician regarding moving the poles. He suggested the elimination of additional poles. This would involve moving a couple of the light fixtures and recommended a stronger high powered wattage that will give more coverage with less lights. Follow up with the electric company is needed.

Carlisle Place Road

Mr. Sarlette questioned was the necessary side work completed on Carlisle Place Road.

Mr. Cormac reported that NJDOT has closed out this project and there was not additional work pending.

Patti Gross offered that the signs that were previously discussed. She found out that the signs were 5' x 8' single faced.

Solicitor

Frank DiDomenico did send a letter to the MRT Historical Society to the attention of Mr. David Ewen, Treasurer regarding the cottage taxation question. This was sent by email and by mail.

He also sent letter today to US Silica attention: Jim Dambrosio regarding the bond. The bond is posted back to 1999 but it does not have adequate coverage to the township. He sent a copy of the form bond sample to him which provides protection to the township and also indicates when the bond can be called.

He reviewed both of the Cumberland County Improvement Authority agreements. EarthTech needs to supply a written agreement that recyclables and wastes will go to the county.

He ordered the title report for 5 Station Road, the Keller property.

The Wawa tax appeal is scheduled for December 3 at the Tax Court in Trenton. An appraisal was received from Associated Appraisal Group with an appraisal of 5.5 million dollars. This

information was forwarded to Wawa's attorney. Wawa's attorney contacted him to settle to 2.5 million. The Tax Assessor has assessed this property at 2.8 million. An increase in taxation can only take place with a counter-claim.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED that the Township Committee of the Township of Maurice River, County of Cumberland, State of New Jersey, does hereby repeal in its entirety, Ordinance No. 191, §3-6 through 3-6.9 of the revised general ordinances of the Township of Maurice River.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Township Committee of the Township of Maurice River, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the adoption and publication of notice of adoption as prescribed by law.

5. The Township Clerk is directed to contact the two (2) contiguous property owners to advise as to the township's sale of the two (2) lots in question as well as to determine whether or not the contiguous land owners wish to purchase the two (2) lots in question.

WHEREAS, State actuaries confirm by the latest Valuation Report the pension and benefit reform enacted in 2010 and 2011, coupled with the consistent pension payments made by employees and local governing bodies, have resulted in the savings; and
