SPECIAL MEETING

This meeting has been advertised in accordance with the statutes of the State of New Jersey. This special meeting was called pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Law. Notice of this meeting was emailed to South Jersey Times on December 22, 2014 and advertised on December 26, 2014. In addition copies of notices were posted on the bulletin board in the Municipal Building and filed in the office of the Municipal Clerk on aforementioned date. Notes on the bulletin board have remained continuously posted. Mayor Sarclette called the meeting to order; the Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Mayor Sarclette called the meeting to order at 7:08 PM noting the purpose of the special meeting is the review of Ordinance 638 and review the 2015 Appointments List (aka: Resolution 01-2015) and general Township Committee Concerns.

Township Committee Concerns

Mr. Sarclette requested changes to name plates and sign in front of the building due to incoming Committeeman, J. Roy Oliver and Municipal Clerk, Denise Peterson.

Mr. Sarclette requested an update on the correspondence to Conchita Grospe regarding her inquiry about property she owns in Maurice River Township. Linda Costello indicated that an explanatory letter was sent to Mrs. Grospe.

Mrs. Gross expressed concern about the graffiti that has been appearing on numerous street signs on Route 616 in Dorchester and Heislerville. Mr. Sarclette asked that a request be forwarded to the Cumberland County Department of Public Works Director requesting the signs be replaced and to also request maintenance to the bridge on Glade Road due to graffiti also.

Mr. Sarclette stated that the resident who removed the material from the cul-de-sac area in Milmay has been asked to return it to the cul-de-sac. There will be a follow up by Gordon Gross to ensure compliance.

ORDINANCE 638 - An Ordinance Fixing Salaries and Compensation Of Certain Officers And Employees Of Maurice River Township, Cumberland County, New Jersey

Mr. Sarclette presented the question of whether the township committee would be seeking a raise in their salary for 2015.

The consensus was that there would be no raise for the township committee members for year 2015.

Review of Ordinance 638 by Mayor Sarclette and Deputy Mayor Patricia Gross took place with necessary corrections noted.
