

DRINKING WATER NOTICE

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Maurice River Township Senior Center

We violated a drinking water requirement. Even though this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have the right to know what happened and what we are doing to correct this situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During 6/1/16-9/30/16 we did not monitor for Lead and Copper and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What This Means

There is nothing you need to do at this time. The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for, how often we are supposed to sample (frequency) and how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were (or will be) taken.

Contaminant	Required sampling frequency	Number of samples taken	When samples should have been taken	When samples were (or will be) taken
Lead and Copper	One sample every 3 year period	5	6/1/16-9/30/16	6/1/17-9/30/17 or before

Steps We Are Taking

We have since taken the required samples, as described in the last column of the table above. The samples showed we are meeting drinking water standards
