## APPLIANCES & TIRES

(appliances to include window a/c units)



*Curbside - LAST WEDNESDAY of each month*



Max. of 4 tires per household per month, off rims. This service is for personal use ONLY. Please do not allow others to place tires on your property for pick up.

## RECYCLABLES COLLECTION

*Curbside - ALTERNATING FRIDAYS (North & South of Rte 670)*

Red recycling containers are available at the Municipal Hall for \$10.  
(55 gallon drums cannot be used.)

## TRASH COLLECTION & BULKY PICK-UP

*Curbside - EVERY FRIDAY (DOES NOT include tv's or electronics)*

- ⇒ This includes trash, furniture, mattresses, etc.
- ⇒ All trash should be bagged no heavier than 40 lbs and limited to 10 bags. A dumpster rental should be considered if you expect to exceed these limits.
- ⇒ If a plastic container is being used to hold bags, the container must have handles and should never be as large as a 55 gallon drum.
- ⇒ DO NOT use recycling containers to dispose of trash.
- ⇒ Carpets are to be cut into 4 ft lengths, rolled and tied, and not exceed 40 lbs.
- ⇒ Large windows and doors must have the glass removed before putting curbside. Place glass in a cardboard box marked "Broken Glass."
- ⇒ Contractors are solely responsible for all debris they generate.
- ⇒ All empty trash containers must be removed from curbside within 12 hours of trash removal.



## WASTE OIL & USED ANTIFREEZE

May be disposed of at the Municipal Garage, 552 Main St, Leesburg.

## STREET LIGHTS

Street light outages may be reported on-line at [www.atlanticcityelectric.com](http://www.atlanticcityelectric.com) or by calling 785-1120 ext 111. In order to locate the proper street light, you will be required to provide the utility pole number and closest house address.

## DOG LICENSES

Renewals are required annually with a valid rabies vaccination.

**Fees:** \$ 7.00 Neutered \$10.00 Non-Neutered  
**With Late Fee:** \$12.00 Neutered \$15.00 Non-Neutered  
(late fee charged after March 31) *N.J.S.A. 26:4-7; Ordinance #446*

## FREE RABIES CLINIC

The Cumberland County Health Department will be sponsoring a rabies clinic on March 12, 2016 at the Leesburg Fire Hall (550 Main St) from 9 to 11 am.

Pet owners should bring proof of latest rabies vaccination.

Dog licenses will also be available at the Municipal Hall (590 Main St, Leesburg).



## 2016 BRUSH & LEAF COLLECTION

Leaves must be raked or blown to curbside, not pushed with machinery as this will cause other debris to mix within the pile. Leaves cannot be in any container or bag; they must be piled in windrow fashion without branches, twigs or trash. **Leaves may be piled curbside two weeks prior to pick up date, but must be curbside on the date indicated below; the truck WILL NOT return.**

## RENTAL REGISTRATION

**Annual Fee:** \$30 per unit (*prior to March 1*) ~ \$60 per unit (*after March 1*)

Inspections are performed annually (prior to June 30) by the Housing Officer to obtain a Continued Certificate of Occupancy (*Ordinance #382*). For more information call 785-1120 ext 132.



## 9-1-1 ADDRESS POSTING

Every residence is required to have its 9-1-1 address posted (4" high) conspicuously on the home or at the end of their driveway; whichever is most visible from the roadway. (*Ordinance #405*)

## WHY TO RECYCLE...

- ♻ Recycling saves natural resources.
- ♻ Recycling vendors report where materials originate from. This affects the amount of grant money MRT receives from the State of New Jersey.
- ♻ Recycling is the LAW!
- ♻ Any questions, please call Louann Karrer at 785-1120 ext 113.

## WHAT TO RECYCLE...

- ♻ All caps/lids from plastic, glass and metal containers should be removed and discarded in the trash since they are not recyclable.
- ♻ All containers should then be washed out with cold water prior to being placed in the recycling container (red bucket).

### PLASTIC...

- ♻ All plastic items with the numbers 1, 2, 4, 5 or 7 are recyclable and can be put in either red recycle container. These numbers can be found on most butter tubs, yogurt containers, milk cartons, juice boxes, soup boxes, soda bottles, laundry detergent bottles and milk jugs.
- ♻ If the plastic item contained motor oil, paint or pesticides, they CANNOT be recycled.

### GLASS...

- ♻ ONLY clear, green and brown food containers and beverage bottles and jars are recyclable.

### METAL...

- ♻ Aluminum, tin, and bimetal cans, which contained food and beverages are recyclable.

### PAPER...

- ♻ Cereal boxes, tissue boxes, newspapers, junk mail, phone books, magazines, office paper, gabled drink boxes, etc. can be recycled together.
- ♻ Papers should not be tied, bundled or put in any bag. Please place in any recycle container for roadside collection.
- ♻ Please do not put shredded paper curbside as it creates a transportation hazard on windy days. This should be held until the annual MRT Shred Day.

### THE FOLLOWING ITEMS CANNOT BE RECYCLED:

Aluminum foil, foil coated items or pie plates ▪ Pizza boxes ▪ Wax containers ▪ Toys  
Pots-n-pans ▪ Tableware ▪ Light Bulbs ▪ Corning Ware® ▪ Tupperware® ▪ Plastic bags,  
pails or trays ▪ Styrofoam® ▪ Vases ▪ Ceramics ▪ Mirrors ▪ Window glass ▪ Motor oil,  
lubricant, paint or pesticide containers ▪ Plastic items with recycling symbol of 3 or 6.

**REMEMBER:** Do not use plastic grocery bags in the red recycle bins!

## SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

Effective January 2015, the County has changed to a Single Stream System for recycling. This means when your recyclables are picked up, everything will go into one truck – TOGETHER! You no longer have to separate your recyclables, but you can continue to use both containers for all recyclables. Your own containers could also be used as long as they are labeled “Recyclables.” You may now also recycle gray boxes, such as tissue boxes, cereal boxes etc.

### CARDBOARD

Flatten your corrugated cardboard, tie it in a bundle and put it curbside with your recycling. OR... you may continue to use the drop-off containers located behind the Municipal Garage (552 Main St), Cumberland Fire Hall (5272 Route 49) or Port Elizabeth Fire Hall (7 Port Eliz Cumb Rd). DO NOT INCLUDE pizza boxes or waxed boxes; these items are trash.



### ELECTRONICS

**TV's, computers, monitors, lap tops, and other similar electronics are no longer accepted at the landfill.**

**THESE ITEMS CANNOT BE PUT CURBSIDE FOR PICK-UP!!**

The township, in cooperation with the CCIA, has received a walk-in shed to facilitate the recycling of electronic components. The building will be open for drop-off during our regular oil recycling dates at the Municipal Garage, 552 Main St, Leesburg.

Monday and Friday 8-10 am

Attendant must be present. ~ For more information call 785-2718.  
(The CCIA has contracted with an agency to recycle these items.)



### FLUORESCENT BULBS/TUBES & BATTERIES

**We no longer accept fluorescent bulbs/tubes at the walk-in shed.**

Please recycle household fluorescent BULBS at The Home Depot.  
(There's a box at the main entrance near the service counter.)

**Household batteries (AA, AAA, C, D, 9-V alkaline) are no longer considered hazardous waste, therefore, can be discarded in your regular trash.**  
**Rechargeable batteries are considered hazardous waste.**
