PERMIT CONDITION

- ✔ Contact local Official(s)/Dispatch at: _____
- ✔ Open burning regulations do not permit the disposal of rubbish, garbage, fallen leaves and yard or trade waste by open burning.
- ✔ Permits are not transferable, must be in the possession of the person doing the burning, and must be shown upon request.
- ✔ Permit holders are not authorized to burn on properties over which they do not have legal control, without written permission of the owner. The permittee and/or property owner must assume all responsibility for their actions and of their agents operating under this permit and for any fire, which may result.
- ✔ The fire must be attended at all times, be constructed so as to prevent escape, be not less than 50 ft. from any permanent structure for EVENT PERMITS, and be fully extinguished before leaving.
- ✔ Regulations as to times, dates, places and conditions of burning will be strictly observed. Check current restrictions at www.njwildfire.org.
